

Utility Buckets

Utility Bucket - Universal Fit buckets also go by the name "slip-on-the-forks" lift truck accessory buckets. These buckets can be utilized along with whatever make and model of extendable reach lift truck. If your unit is unable to be matched with a quick-tach unit, another new or used universal fit bucket could be located instead. Typical universal forklift buckets attach to forks that are up to six inches wide and are forty eight inches long. Larger fork pockets could be prearranged via an account manager upon request.

Because they slip directly onto the forks, universal fit buckets stay on the machine and are less at risk to destruction. Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50 percent. This extra space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.

In addition, constructed as attachments for extendable-reach lift trucks, Quick-Tach buckets, are designed to allow the placement of materials far beyond the normal reach of the loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on the leading edge and on both sides reinforces strength, resistance to wear and tear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach forklift buckets are augmented by scuff bars along the bottom of the unit which shield it from abrasion.

Quick-Tach lift truck buckets could be used to replace the carriage and blades which weigh between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. When installed, these buckets free up more of the unit's cargo capacity, enabling it to handle heavier and larger items. The Quick-Tach is able to dump materials around 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are designed in a custom fashion in order to meet all the specs of particular models and makes of forklifts.
